

## **NEW STREET LIGHTS**

Through National Grids Energy Conservation Program the Village was able to convert all of its out dated high pressure sodium street lights to new energy efficient LED lights at no cost to the Village. These new lights save energy and they cost less to operate.

Currently the Village is working with National Grid through the same Energy Conservation Program to have a no cost energy audit conducted at all of our Municipal facilities to further reduce our energy usage.

BUILDING PERMITS Building permits are required in the Village. Please check with the Building Code Officer, Dave Heckman 716 484-3173 BEFORE you start your project.

CURFEW: All individuals under the age of 18, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, MUST be off the Village Streets from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

RUBBISH AND GARBAGE: Garbage or rubbish can not be stored or accumulated on any premises in the Village. Exterior property must be kept free from conditions which could create health or safety hazards or fire. This includes keeping your lawns mowed and free of debris
