RECYCLE

- NO CONTRACTOR BAGS

• ALL GARBAGE SHOULD BE AT CURBSIDE BY 7:00 A.M.

- ALL GARBAGE NEEDS TO BE IN SINCLAIRVILLE BAGS – NO LOOSE HOUSEHOLD TRASH
- RECYCLING MAY BE MIXED, BUT NEEDS TO BE CLEAN AND ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING
- ACCEPTABLE CARDBOARD: All non-coated or non-contaminated cardboard and paper boxes, paper towel and toilet paper tubes & paper bags. Please have cardboard flattened. Large amounts should be bundled – No large boxes please!
- ACCEPTABLE GLASS: Food, beverage containers & jars of any color. Must be clean!
- ACCEPTABLE PLASTIC: Containers, bottles & jugs #1 - #7 (# located on bottom of container) such as food, beverage, beauty, cleaning projects, detergents, butter, yogurt, and sour cream containers.
- ACCEPTABLE METAL: Household and kitchen items such as aluminum soda and pet food cans, pie plates, trays, tin cans and small metal containers.
- ACCEPTABLE PAPER: Newspaper, junk mail, envelopes, clean milk & juice containers, egg cartons, magazines & SOFT cover books.
- NOT ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING: Take out containers, plastic bags, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, Pyrex, ceramics, paper towels, facial tissue, Styrofoam, any item with food waste in it, paint, oils, hazardous material, needles, syringes, VCR tapes and CD & DVD'S
