ART KIBBE

Born in 1927 in the Town of Charlotte Art moved into the Village in 1959. Art is a World War II veteran and at 96 years young is one of the oldest WWII veterans in the area.

After serving overseas he returned home to serve his community, and serve he did. Art was a rural letter carrier for both Sinclairville and Gerry post offices, a job he dearly loved. This job not only allowed him to serve the community, but being an avid hunter, it offered him the opportunity to scope out where the best turkey and deer hunting areas may be.

Art was a NYS Turkey Caller, Novice Class 1st Place winner.

He also drove the sports buses for CVCS, coached Babe Ruth Baseball, was scorekeeper for the Casadaga Bombers Baseball Team.

Every Memorial Day Art would put on that old Army uniform (which still fit him) to honor the Veterans. He served as the Color Guard and Sergeant of the Firing Squad for the Village's Memorial Day Observance.

Art still lives in the same house he has for over 60 years where he raised a family of 6 kids along with his wife Bessie. They were married for over 71 years. Bessie spent her time serving the Village planting and caring for foliage throughout the Village.

ARE YOU AWARE OF SOME OF OUR LAWS

DOG LEASH LAW. Dogs are not permitted to run at large in the Village. All dogs must be confined to their own property unless on a leash. Please do not let your dogs run unleashed at the Village Parks

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG IF YOU TAKE HIM FOR A WALK

OPEN BURNING Prohibited State-Wide! Small campfires are allowed.

NEVER LEAVE A BURNING FIRE UNATTENDED

BUILDING PERMITS Building permits are required in the Village. Please check with the Building Code Officer, Dave Heckman 716 484-3173 **BEFORE** you start your project.

CURFEW: All individuals under the age of 18, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, **MUST** be off the Village Streets from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

RUBBISH AND GARBAGE: Garbage or rubbish can not be stored or accumulated on any premises in the Village. Exterior property must be kept free from conditions which could create health or safety hazards or fire. This includes keeping your lawns mowed and free of debris.
